INTERNATIONAL ARFF TRAINING

Training Program:

Three courses are offered as part of this comprehensive training program. All courses are scheduled to take place concurrently during a two-week period. Students can either enrol into one course (1-week) or can enrol in any two courses of their choice (2-weeks).

> RESPOND TO AIRCRAFT **INCIDENTS**

TARGET: Firefighters / Senior firefighters **DURATION:** 5 Days

This rigorous course is designed in alignment with ICAO Standards to provide both theoretical and practical training that will substantially improve the expertise and capabilities of ARFF firefighters. Participants will be trained in state-of-the-art operational tactics, enabling them to efficiently handle a broad spectrum of incidents related to aircraft and airports, utilizing the most advanced equipment and vehicles.

SENIOR AIRPORT FIRE **OFFICER**

TARGET: Senior Airport Fire Officers / Commanders **DURATION: 5 Days**

The internationally recognised Senior Airport Fire Officer (SAFO) course will empower Supervisors and those providing command functions during an incident with the skills and knowledge to manage teams and effectively control an incident.

A large range of topics will be covered including Legislation & Standards, Incident Command Systems, Airport Emergency Planning, Managing Mass Casualties, Incident Investigation, Task & Resource Analysis, Human Factors, Firefighter Training and much more.

EMERGENCY **RESPONSE DRIVER TRAINING**

TARGET: Firefighters / Drivers and Supervisors

DURATION: 5 Davs

TThe ARFF Emergency Response Driving Workshop will provide theoretical and practical knowledge and understanding to respond safely to ARFF incidents. The training is in accordance with ICAO and NFPA standards, and includes Initial skills training and maintenance of competency. The course content is internationally accredited by SFJ Awards (UK).
